The humanitarian costs of the coronavirus outbreak have continued to mount, with more than 80,000 people infected in China alone, where the outbreak originated. The number of people who have been confirmed to have died as a result of the virus has now surpassed 3,800.

It has hit a growing list of companies by sapping consumer demand in key regions and disrupting supply chains. Chinese stocks, the travel sector and energy funds have also been hit.

The FT is mapping the coronavirus and its economic impact as it spreads. Check back for our up-to-date figures.

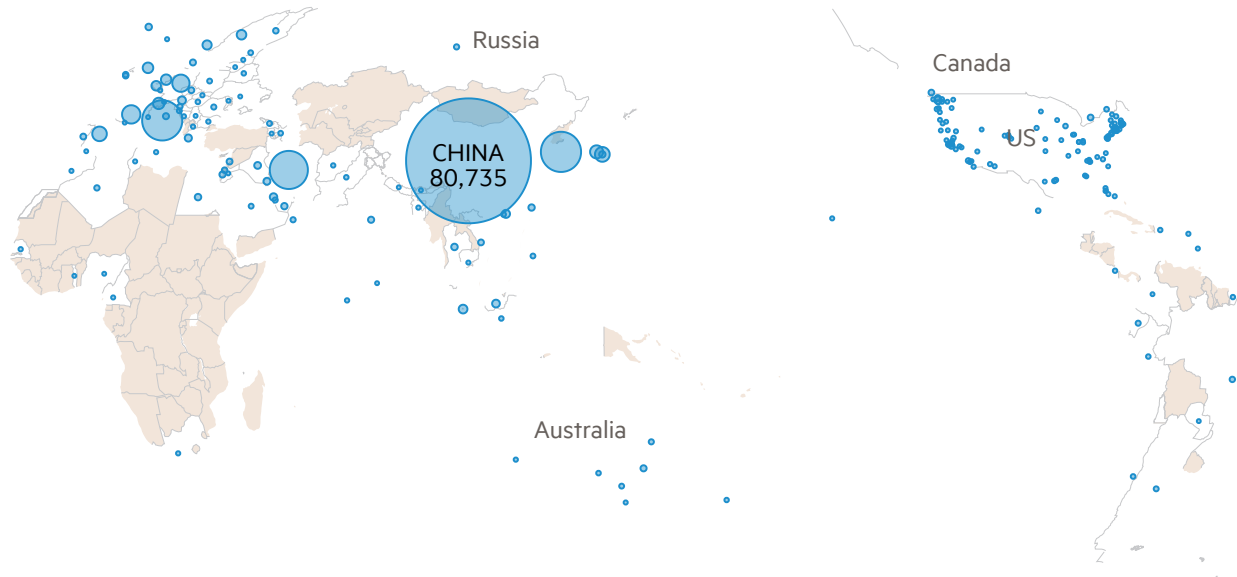

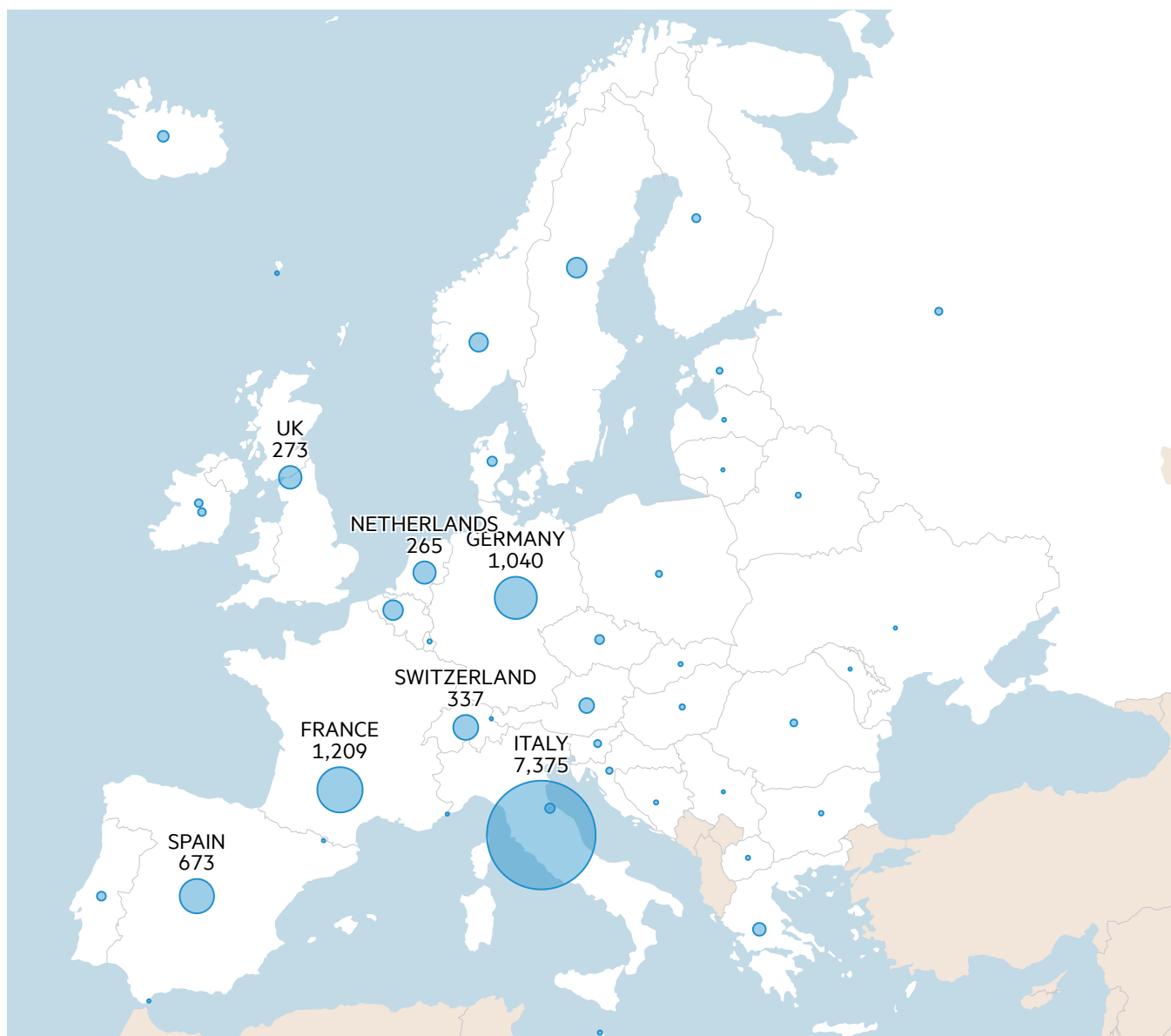

The data for this map comes from a [dashboard](#) maintained by the Johns Hopkins University Center for Systems Science Engineering, which has [combined data](#) from the World Health Organization, the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control, the Chinese Center for Disease Control and Prevention. It also incorporates data from the Chinese medical community website DXY, which aggregates live situation reports from the Chinese National Health Commission and local CCDC.

The coronavirus has now taken hold in Europe, with the largest number of confirmed cases in Italy. Only two countries remain unaffected Albania and Cyprus.

Total cases confirmed as of 5:43am Mar 9 GMT

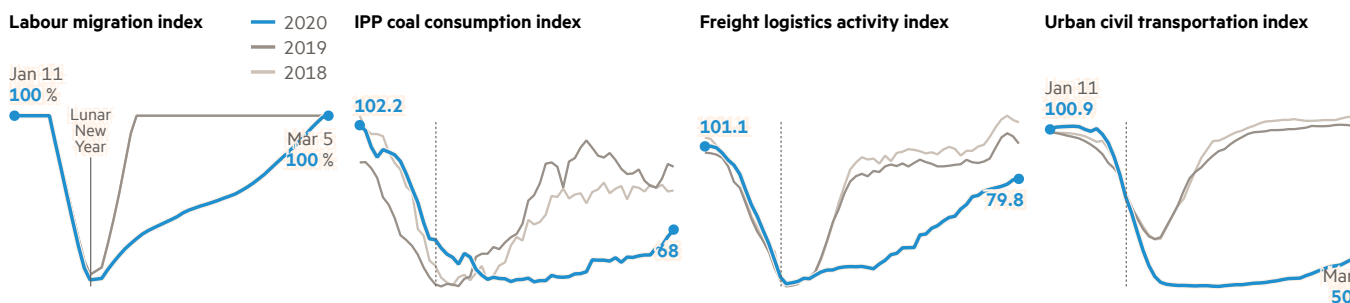

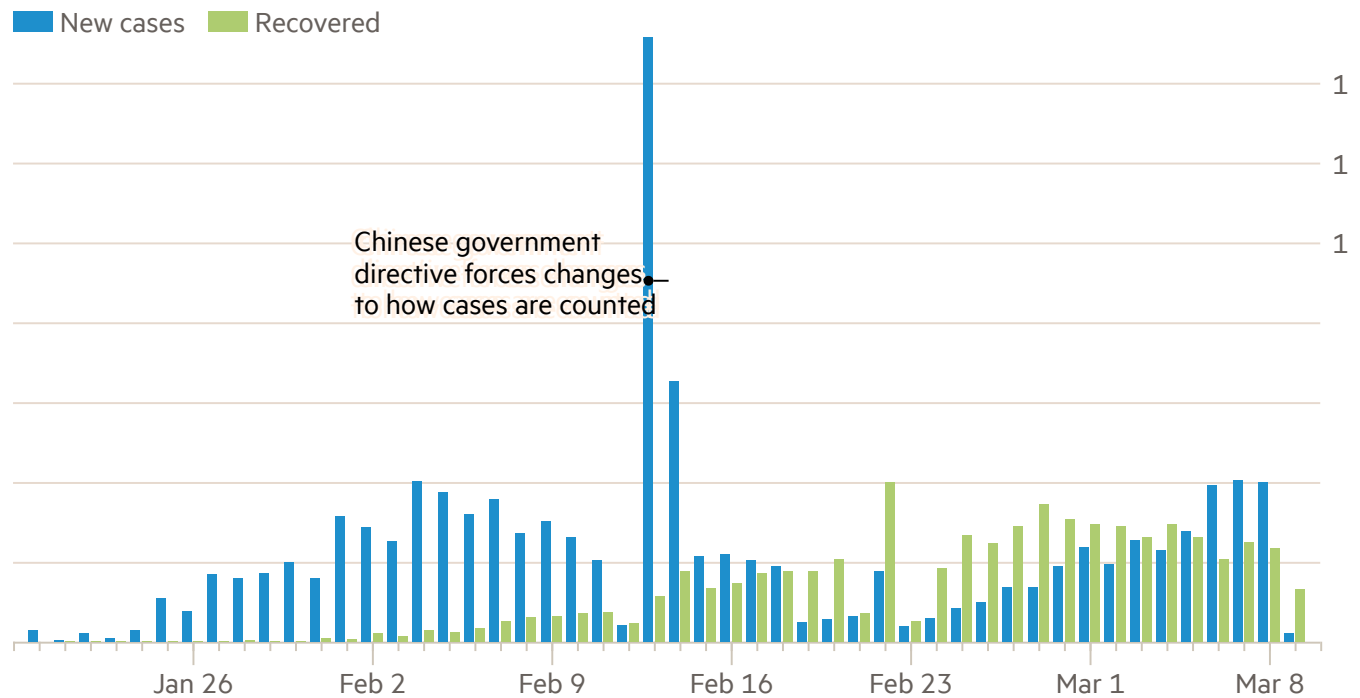
### About the China indicators:

- The **IPP coal consumption index** tracks the volume of coal use reported by the six largest independent power producers
- The **Labour migration index** estimates the per cent of migrant workers who have returned to their city of employment
- The **Freight logistics activity index** is a combination of capacity utilisation of heavy trucks and activity in industrial parks
- The **Urban civil transportation index** combines traffic congestion and subway traffic in major cities

New coronavirus cases are now rising faster outside China than within. The total number of recovered cases has now reached 62,000.
